We are pleased to inform you that the Scouts Association of Mongolia is organizing the International Friendship Camp in conjunction with the 40th year Anniversary of the Nairamdal International Children's Complex. This Camp will be held from 15th to 22nd July, 2018 at the Nairamdal International Children's Complex.

Details as follows:

Name of Event	: International Friendship Camp
Dates	: 15th to 22nd July, 2018 Participants are requested to arrive on 15 th July at Chingiss Khaan International Airport and leave the Jamboree site on 22 nd July, 2018.
Schedule of Camp	: (Sunday) – 15 th July – Arrival date (Monday) – 16 th July – Opening Ceremony (Tuesday) – 17 th July – Programme & Activity (Wednesday) – 18 July – Programme & Activity (Thursday) – 19 th July – Celebration of 40 th Anniversary of Nairamdal (Friday) – 20 th July – Programme & Activity (Saturday) – 21 st July – Programme & Activity – Closing Ceremony (Sunday) – 22 nd July – Departure day
Venue	: “Nairamdal International Children's Complex” – Nairamdal is located in 27 kilometers from Ulaanbaatar City, Capital of Mongolia.
Eligibility	: Participants: Scouts and Guides aged 12 to 17 years old. Adult: Adult Leader 18 up
Overview Program	: The Program will include Module activities, Opening and Closing ceremonies, Gala concert, Celebration of 40 th Anniversary of “Nairamdal International Children's Complex”. Module Activities divided into 2 activity centers include: ➤ Indoor activity ➤ Outdoor activity

Camp Fee	: Participants: 250 USD (INR. 17,500/-). The fee covers food, tent and participant's kit, local transportation from the airport to the venue. Overseas participants in order to encourage early payment of participation fee 200 USD, if participation fee paid before 1st April 2018.
Air-fare and Visa charges	: New Delhi ⇌ Chingiss Khaan International Airport (Mongolia) – INR. 1,10,000/- (Approximately) (Including Visa Charges).
Climate	: Mongolia's land of temperature extremes. The average annual temperature in Mongolia ranges from 16°C (-2°F) in February to a more comfortable 16°C (62°F) in July. Summer fades quickly, and by September the annual average temperature drops to 8°C (48°F) during the camp weather will be 17°C (night time) and 28°C (day time).
Caution Money	: Rs. 5000/- , Non-refundable; if selected and not participated. Demand Draft in the name of "Bharat Scouts & Guides", payable at New Delhi
Last Date of Application	: As the quota is limited, selection will be on the basis of " FIRST COME FIRST SERVE " The applications of the participating candidates should reach to National Headquarters, New Delhi on or before 15th March, 2018 along with photocopy of valid passport and caution money.
